


Body Condition Score (BCS) for Cats



Very Thin

20%+ under ideal weight

- Ribs, spine and hip bones are visible (coat may interfere with visibility)
- Fat can not be seen or felt under the skin
- Obvious loss of muscle mass

Thin

- Ribs, spine and hip bones are visible (coat may interfere with visibility)
- Fat can not be seen or felt under the skin
- Obvious loss of muscle mass

Ideal

- Ribs, spine and hip bones are easily felt and may be visible (coat may interfere with visibility)
- A waist and abdominal tuck are seen when viewed from above and side
- Fat can be felt around ribs, spine and hip bones

Ribs, spine and hip

Overweight

- bones are not visible and difficult to feel
 • Excess fat is felt around
- ribs, spine and hip bones
 Waist and abdominal
- Waist and abdomina tuck are minimal or absent

Obesity

30%+ over ideal weight

- Ribs, spine and hip bones are difficult to feel under a thick layer of fat
- Waist and abdomen distended when viewed from above and side
- Prominent fat deposits over lower spine, neck and chest
